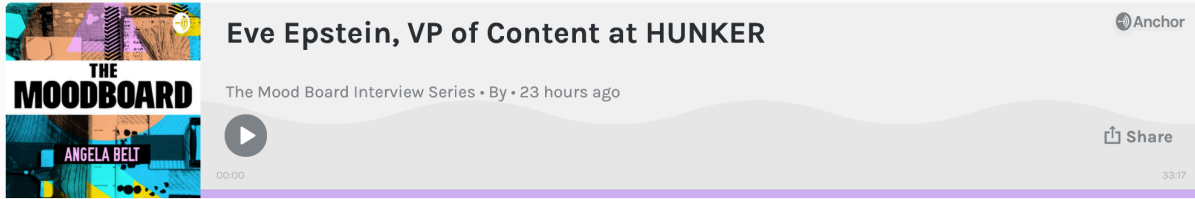


Hunker Featured on The Mood Board

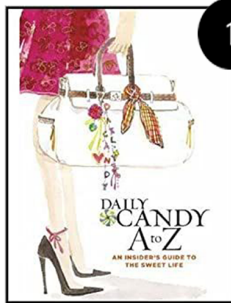

Eve grew up in New York City and attended Williams College where she obtained her Bachelor of Arts in English. She now resides in Los Angeles.

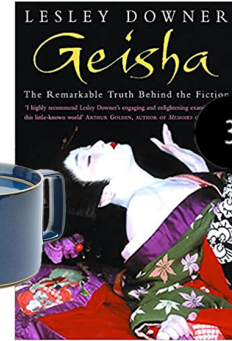

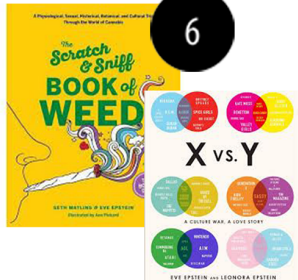
